- *Whirlpool* brand offers the industry's most energy efficient side-by-side refrigerator and the *Maytag* brand offers the industry's most efficient four-door refrigerator. By exceeding efficiency standards by 30 percent, these refrigerators exceeds ENERGY STAR guidelines, helping consumers reduce their family's carbon footprint. These models also use less energy than a 60-watt incandescent light bulb and are the most energy efficient side-by-side and four-door refrigerators ever. *Maytag* and *Whirlpool* brands also offer the most energy efficient French-door bottom mount refrigerators available among leading brands.
